1. Welcome

Ahmed Ahmed (AA), Omar Khan (OK) and Chetan Parmar (CP) welcomed all to the BOMSS Annual General Meeting.

2. President Report

Ahmed Ahmed (AA) thanked CP for the introduction and advised all members to read the BOMSS Yearbook 2026, which includes all detailed reports from the committee chairs.

AA highlighted an increase in membership. There is a 17% increase in IHP membership, an important figure that he would like to continue rising, alongside the overall membership of BOMSS.

AA thanked OK for his work on the Obesity Pathway Guidelines that were unveiled at the 2026 ASM.

AA thanked trustees Richard Welbourn and James Byrne for their work on finance and governance aspects of the society over the last year.

3. Secretary's Report

Chetan Parmar (CP) shared the previous AGM minutes; no queries were received with the minutes being approved.

CP thanked the outgoing Council members, Dee Wainwright (Patient Safety Chair) and wished Veronica Giudice (IHP Dietetic Lead) well who will shortly be going on maternity leave.

4. Treasurer's Report

Omar Khan (OK) confirmed that BOMSS have partnered with Rathbones to make BOMSS funds go further to support future projects.

OK confirmed that some concerns were raised at last year's ASM/AGM. BOMSS received a letter from the Charity Commission, who advised BOMSS do not need to take any further action.

A Governance Committee has been formed and reviews of multiple aspects of BOMSS are underway, including a review of the Constitution. This review coincides with BOMSS's Five Year Anniversary, which Council feel is a good timing.
